Origin European Oak (Quercus Robur) mainly over 80 years old. Grown in responsibly managed central European forests.

Maintenance This finish can be cleaned regularly using our Natural Oil Soap, which feeds and strengthens the surface over time and makes the patina richer and deeper.

Spot repair and Refinish Professional maintenance with our Maintenance natural Oil will make this finish richer and protect it over time. Spot repairs are possible with our touch-up kit.


